

## **Admission Guidelines**

- Age requirements for Early Years, Grade 1, and Grade 2 will be strictly adhered to without any exceptions.
- If your child has any learning issues or special needs, please indicate this on the application form.
- Admission is granted based on the completion of all required documentation and academic merit.
- Siblings will be given preference for admission, but admission is not guaranteed.
- Changing streams once enrolled in Grade 11 is not possible.
- The fee structure is clearly defined and is non-negotiable. No subsidies or discounts will be provided.
- Fees must be paid according to the specified dates. Failure to comply will result in fines.
- Non-payment of fees may lead to removing the student's name from the school rolls.
- There will be no refund of fees under any circumstances.
- In the event of mid-year withdrawal, the full annual fee must be paid.
- Transfer certificates will only be issued if the full annual fee has been paid.
- The Advanced Science program operates under a no-transfer or refund policy.

- We do not entertain any influence or external pressure in the admission process.
- Our admissions process is designed to be transparent and fair, ensuring that all applicants are treated equitably.
- Transition from Ekya Early Years to Grade 1
  - The transition of a child from Ekya Early Years to Primary Grade (Grade 1) will be considered a new admission, rather than a re-admission.
  - Fee The standard yearly increase in fees will not apply during this transition. Instead, the fee structure applicable to new admissions will be enforced.
  - As a special benefit for Ekya Early Years students, the admission fee will be waived for those transitioning to Grade 1, provided the transition is completed by 31st January.
  - Please note that Ekya Early Years operates independently from Ekya School, which includes the Primary, Middle, and Senior School divisions.
